Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Yet, this Lenten season that is what we are called to do. As Saint Peter reminds us, we humble ourselves under God's mighty hand. That no matter how hard we may work, we cannot free ourselves from our sinful condition. We are trapped. We need One stronger and mightier than ourselves to come and save us from sin, death, and the Devil.

He comes in humility in flesh and bone, born of the Virgin Mary, to be lifted up in due time on the cross, to suffer, bleed, and die for us. He bears all of our sins in order that we might be forgiven of them and reconciled back to God once again. That we have a God who loves us. We have One who hears our every prayer and cares about all of our anxiety and concerns, no matter how small they might be.

The stronger One has come and saves us! This alone should bring us great joy. Even more when we realize that God shows His care for us every day. He daily gives us newness of life. He gives us the weather, even as much as we may complain about it, to water and grow the fruits of the earth. He listens to us and helps us through every need, anxiety, and concern we may have, granting us His comfort and peace that surpasses all understanding. That we may indeed cast all our anxiety on Him.

As we gather to confess our sins and receive His forgiveness this Lententide, may we always give thanks for His being lifted up upon the cross for us men and our salvation.
